
I WELCOME CENTRE


Through 72 years of ministry, the story of the body grew...

NURSERY (0 - 24 mos)

Our Sunday Nursery is a safe and clean environment with ample space for your babies to play, explore, crawl and interact with other children their age. We also have a Quiet Room for nursing mothers during the 9am & 11am services.

2-YEAR-OLDS

This class is in an age appropriate classroom with bathroom faciliites. It is a great place to move, play, sing, and learn simple Bible principals.

3-4 YEAR-OLDS

This is by far the happiest and most energetic group! They begin their time with free play, then they have a Bible story, a snack and do a craft to reinforce the learning. They are encouraged to learn and share with their parents a monthly key Bible truth and verse.

ELEMENTARY (K - Gr 4)

Each Sunday begins with a large group time of worship, prayer and experiencing God's Word. After this, they divide into age groups to discuss their lesson further while participating in games, crafts and activities.

ROUTE 56 (Gr 5 & 6)

On Sunday mornings this age group experiences worship time with their families in the main service and then goes downstairs for their Bible lesson, discussions, games and activities. On the first Sunday of every month, they will spend the full service with their families. Every third Friday of the month we provide a monthly activity called "Route 56" to develop stronger relationships and connections.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Children's Ministry lays a biblical foundation for lifelong faith, giving children opportunities to develop their relationship with Jesus Christ. Our goal is for the children to grow in character and reach out to those who do not know Christ through a lifestyle of service.

(Activism and the Inner Life) Feb.9-10, 2024

Historically, evangelical Christians have valued these four distinctive and crucial points:

Biblicism A deep reverence for the Bible and its unsurpassed authority

Crucicentrism An unwavering resolve that Jesus' death and resurrection provides forgiveness for sins and a new life.

Conversionism It is not enough to acknowledge Jesus's work on the cross. This value emphasizes that every person that humbly comes to Jesus and trusts

Jesus to provide a life of holiness will receive His grace.

Activism As ones that have received the mercy and grace of Jesus, we go into the world with a message of love that reveals that we are followers of Jesus.

While each of these distinguishing values is being challenged, some would say that the value of activism has slipped the farthest in the evangelical church. In this Conference we will welcome Wayne Stapleton (NAB - VP of Cross-Cultural Engagement & Emerging Leader Engagement) to guide us in how Jesus is calling the church to step out of her self-preservation comfort zone and into a world that so desperately needs to be influenced by the love of those followers of Jesus that have open serving hands rather than clenched fists.

I STEPHEN MINISTRY

Care receivers are people—congregation members and others in our community—who receive care from a Stephen Minister. These are people struggling through a difficult time in life—experiencing grief, divorce, job loss, chronic or terminal illness, or some other life crisis.

A Stephen Minister usually provides care to one person at a time, meeting with that person once a week for about an hour.

Twice a month, Stephen Ministers gather with their Stephen Leaders for supervision and continuing education.
